

## MONUMENT VALLEY RIDE

Tentative ride dates are: 9/18/11 – 9/23/11

**\*This is a self contained base camp ride.\***

Ride the range where the Navajo let their horses, cattle and sheep graze together. Where yarn is spun from wool and rugs are still woven by hand. The most peaceful valley you will ever have the opportunity to visit. Travel the same land that was made famous by John Ford and his wonderful western movies. This is a most unique place to camp and ride. With towering monuments made of beautiful red stone. Spectacular formations with names like: 3 Sisters, Rooster Rock, Totem Pole and The Mittens. See wild flowers of many colors and even a stream or two.

In the evening we will have Navajo singers around the camp fire and learn their dances. Our Navajo hosts will also be there telling stories of their ancestors and their own lives in Monument Valley.

Your horse should be in good condition. It's not a difficult ride but there is a lot of sand and some hills that we will be going up and a few rocky areas. Approximate time on the trail including lunch: Monday & Tuesday 6 hours. Wednesday 7 hours. Thursday 3 hours. Friday 2 hours. (We stop a lot for Navajo stories).

**THE RIDE WILL PROVIDE: Dinner on Sunday, Wednesday & Thursday. Also: Horse Water, Showers & Port-a-Potties.**

**YOU PROVIDE: Feed for your horse. Your breakfast, lunch & plenty of drinking water for you.**

On Monday & Tuesday we will potluck. If everyone fixes an item that will serve approx. 4 than that will also provide for our Navajo guests as well. You actually only fix a small amount for dinner twice all week. Now that's a vacation! It's fun, easy and everyone gets to know each other.

**Required: Coggins Test & Health Certificates.** (Destination: Monument Valley, UT 84536)
